There is no better way to enjoy Autumn Glory than to travel our scenic byways and take in some of our beautiful historic spots and vistas throughout the county. Our two fall foliage tours provide you with a self-guided tour where you will travel along some of our most stunning routes and have the opportunity to stop by some famous historic sites. Keep the camera handy and enjoy!

Fall Foliage Heritage Driving Tour – Southern Garrett County

This self-guided driving tour will highlight the splendor of Garrett County's fall foliage in the Southern end of the county. While traveling along some of Maryland's Scenic Byways, you'll see the gorgeous colors of fall everywhere you look. Take your time, drive a little slower and take in the beauty of autumn! This route will also take you by the historic Fort Alice Walking Trail. In 1861, Fort Alice was constructed to guard a vital railroad crossing over the Youghiogheny River. An attack in April 1863 ended with the burning of the bridge and portions of the Fort being destroyed, shutting down the railroad for some time. Continuing your drive, you will also see the Mountain Lake Park Ticket Office Museum. This beautifully restored building contains historic artifacts and relics from Mountain Lake Park; call ahead for days and times of operation. Along your drive thru Mountain Lake Park, you'll notice some stunning Victorian homes that are listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

Fall Foliage Heritage Driving Tour – Northern Garrett County

This self-guided tour will take you through some of the county's most spectacular scenery! Enjoy driving along some of Maryland's Scenic Byways to see some of the sights and colors of fall! Along this path you will drive down the National Historic Road, the first nationally funded road in the United States. You'll also pass the Casselman Inn and the historic Casselman Bridge! Don't forget to stop and shop at Spruce Forest Artisan Village. You'll find one-of-a-kind treasures created by the artisans who work in the village's cabins. You'll finish with a drive back to the Garrett County Visitors Center, but don't forget to have your camera ready along the way as you'll travel along more of Maryland's Scenic Byways. Don't be surprised if you have some wildlife sightings on these gorgeous fall days! There really is no better way to spend an autumn day in Garrett County.
