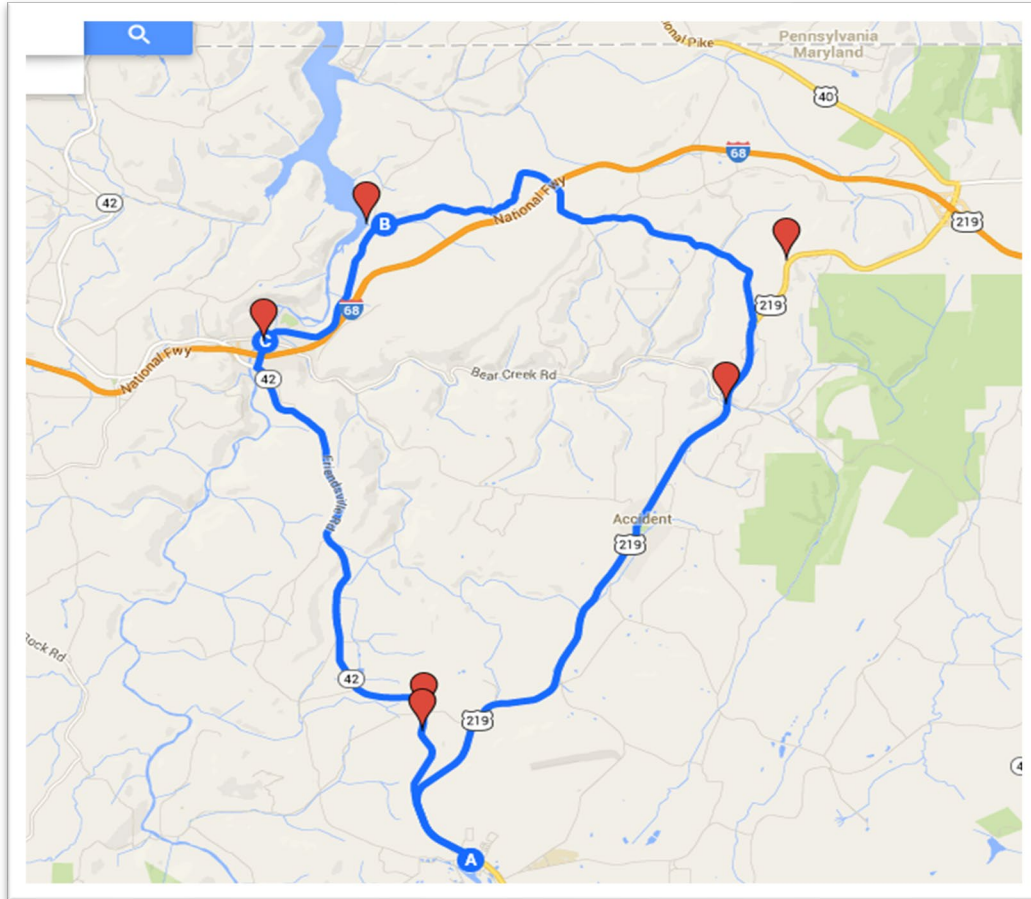


Fall Foliage Driving Tours 2024

Directions:

- A. Start at Garrett County Chamber of Commerce/Visitors Center, 15 VISITORS CENTER DR., MCHENRY 21541
- B. Turn LEFT onto GARRETT HWY (US-219, North)
- C. Turn LEFT onto Cove Road, located just past Northern Garrett High School. (See Side Trip Below)
 - **Scenic Overlook**, overlooking what is known as the Cove. **Great photo opportunity!**
Directions: Continue past Cove Road, you will see signs for the Scenic Overlook located on the left.
- D. Follow Cove Rd., turn RIGHT after Griffith Rd to stay on Cove Rd. Cove Rd becomes Old Morgantown Rd, stay straight to follow Old Morgantown Road.
 - View #16 Old Maid's Puzzle Barn Quilt, owned by Jim & Ruby Margroff, 886 Cove Road Accident, MD 21520
- E. Turn LEFT onto Friendsville Addison Rd at the T intersection toward Friendsville.
- F. Friendsville Addison Rd becomes 2nd Street once in Friendsville

- Public access to the Wild and Scenic Youghiogheny River: Friendsville is one of only three points in the county.
 - View the #19 Double Wedding Ring Barn Quilt, Owned by Jeremiah & Amanda Guard, at
 - 3277 Friendsville Addison Road, Friendsville, MD 21531 | (you may pull into the driveway to stop to take pictures of the barn quilt) | 39.70464, -79.365824
- G. Turn RIGHT onto Maple Street. Head east on Maple St. toward 1st Ave (See Side Trips & Points of Interest below.)
- Friendsville – Bring a picnic lunch to enjoy in the town park located next to the designated “Wild & Scenic”, Youghiogheny River or find a tasty bite to eat in town. Friendsville is also home to the Friend Family Heritage Museum which includes a historical library and located in a former bank building. Find a tour guide or outfitter and book a family float trip, kayaking or whitewater adventure!
 - Take a hike on the Kendall Trail: Morris Ave. and Oak St. (Friendsville) 2-mile trail
- H. Turn RIGHT on 1st Ave.
- I. Turn LEFT onto MD-42 / Friendsville Rd toward US 219 South / Garrett Highway.
- **Side Trip Hot Spot: Schoolhouse Earth** | 1224 Friendsville Rd | | 301-746-8603 | Mon-Sun 10am-6pm. Offering the finest selection of unique gifts, hot collectibles, year-round Christmas showroom and gourmet food. Daily rotation of food samples available for visitors & a free petting zoo to enjoy while you shop.
 - Historical Marker: Meshack Browning grave site (.25 mile south of Hoyes Rd, East side) There is a small turn off to park a car.
- J. Merge on US-219 South
- K. Turn RIGHT onto Visitors Center Dr., return to Garrett County Visitors Center.

Note: Cell phone availability intermittent; GPS navigation units ok
